Founder and Director, Hong Kong Schools' Self Evaluation Network (HKSSSEN)

Archie was Her Majesty's Chief Inspector of Schools ([HMIE -Scotland](#)) from 1987-2000. He chaired one of the four OECD international networks which developed international education indicators (1992-1997) which appear annually in the OECD annual publication 'Education at a Glance'. As such, he has played a central role, both in Scotland and globally, in promoting school self-evaluation and improvement complemented by external school review or inspection.

As first Director of the HMI Audit Unit, he led the Quality Initiative in Scotland which brings together schools, education authorities and funding bodies, and national government in a co-ordinated approach to raising standards for all pupils.

Archie is founder-director (November 2003) of the Hong Kong Schools' Self-evaluation Network (HKSSSEN) along with the Education Bureau of Hong Kong and leading school principals.
